

Save Even More With Rebates

Using Overdrive Directional Beam Angled and EH80 fixtures can instantly save on your electricity bills, but you can also qualify for valuable rebates as well. These units are EnergyStar certified making it eligible for rebates incentives.

Where are rebates available?

Rebates can come from a variety of sources such as utilities, municipalities, states, and non-profit organizations. With over 3,000 utilities across North America, rebates vary greatly between locations. Currently, 74% of the US is covered by a commercial lighting rebate program.

How do rebate programs work?

Depending on the project's location, the Overdrive lamps (either Directional or EH80 series) likely fall under a prescriptive or an instant rebate program.

With a prescriptive program, you do the project, file the paperwork, and typically the rebate is received about 10 – 12 weeks later as a check. Unlike rebates for household products, prescriptive rebates typically require pre-approval from the rebate program before installation begins.

An instant program is where the lighting must be purchased from a participating distributor in the Instant Rebate Program. They take the rebate directly of the invoice and file the rebate paperwork with the utility later.

Either way, it's good to do your research before committing to a project.

How much of a rebate can the Overdrive bulbs receive?

The rebate amount varies depending on project specifics. Some areas will calculate the rebate as a set incentive per unit installed. Others will base the incentive on watts of kilowatt hours saved.
